BarleyCorn's has offered to have a special menu for us, in addition to the normal restaurant menu. Thanks to Lion Allan for arranging this for us.

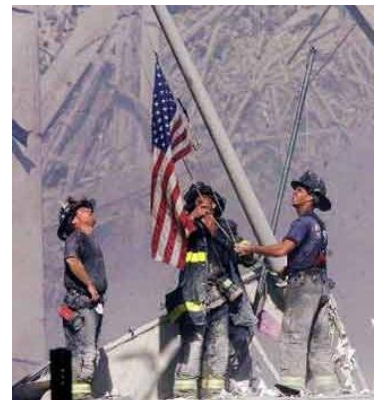
